

HOLYHEAD – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 17/2024

Terminals 3 and 5 Works in Progress and Special Direction

Issued 21st December 2024
Expires On completion of works

Remedial works involving diving and the use of marine plant will be conducted in way of Ro-Ro Terminals 3 and 5 for a period of time.

Terminal 3 will be temporarily closed until completion of the works.

When permitted, vessels using Terminal 5 are to do so with extreme caution keeping in mind the works being undertaken on the adjacent berth.

Vessels undertaking the works may be Restricted in their Ability to Manoeuvre and will carry the appropriate shapes and lights to indicate this.

Mariners are requested to give the area a wide berth and keep wave wash to a minimum.

Special Direction

Due to a dangerous structure in the vicinity of Terminal 3, without the specific permission of the Harbour Master, Deputy Harbour Master or Port Control, no vessel as defined under the Harbour Byelaws or the Merchant Shipping (Watercraft) Order 2023 is permitted to enter the area as defined on the accompanying chartlet.
