

HOLYHEAD – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 07/2024

Deep Water Jetty – Lights Extinguished

Issued 5th March 2024
Expires 6th March 2024

Due to overrunning engineering works and technical issues the navigation lights and causeway lights on the Deep Water Jetty will be extinguished from Sunset Tuesday 5th until Sunrise Wednesday 6th March.

Floodlights have been positioned at the North and South ends as a temporary measure.

Port Control will make an hourly broadcast on Ch14 and also remind vessel approaching / transiting the Harbour.
